Dear Parent/Carer

We are delighted to inform you of our plans for the third and final Aspire day of this academic year, on Thursday 11 July. This is the same day as the Thorpe Park reward trip. All students with the exception of those attending the Thorpe Park will be taking part. For this ASPIRE day we will be running the charity house walks. This is a great opportunity to explore our local surroundings, enjoy a physical activity and raise money for our nominated House Charities.

Each house walk will be start and end at Bournemouth Pier and will be led by House staff (please see table below for the meeting points) and be approx. 7 miles long. Please ensure your child wears appropriate clothing and footwear for this event, including sun screen or rain coats depending on the weather on the day. Each group will have a designated first aider and any student with mobility issues will be supported to ensure they can take part in a safe and appropriate manner.

If your child is eligible for free school meals, a packed lunch will be provided for them, however, they will still need additional drinks for the day. All other students must bring a packed lunch. Your child will be dismissed from the end point as per the table above. Parents and carers are responsible for the journey to and from these meeting points and these are all serviced by local buses. Please note there will be no lessons and staff onsite on this day other than to ensure attendance arrangements are followed as normal.
