Dragons Den- You will learn key business communication skills through pitching your business ideas to The Bourne Dragons.

Trips- You will get a chance to visit local and national businesses which will allow you to apply your developed skills to real life context.

How is Business Studies Assessed?

All learners will study three mandatory topics as follows:

- Enterprise and marketing concepts
- Design a business proposal
- Market and pitch a business proposal

One unit is assessed by an exam, whilst the remaining two are coursework.

Who is This Course For?

This qualification is for learners aged 14-16 who wish to develop applied knowledge and practical skills in enterprise and marketing. It is designed with both practical and theoretical elements, which will prepare students for further study of qualifications in enterprise, marketing or business. For example, learners may progress onto A Levels in related subjects.

Where Can Business Take You?

Students can pursue further on to studying A-Level Business as well as a University Degree. Business compliments subjects such as English, Maths, Computing, Law and even Psychology. There are plenty of Apprenticeships related to Business such as Marketing, Design and Engineering, Finance, Accounting and Banking.
