- Carefully curated by teachers to support memory retention and inclusive of diverse learning needs.



How will Knowledge Organisers help my child?

- Aid in remembering and building upon what they've learned.
- Promote sequential learning and continual retrieval of prior knowledge.
- Teachers will guide students on specific sections to focus on each lesson.

How will teachers assess understanding and retention of knowledge?

- Through planned lessons with knowledge retrieval activities.
- This ensures continual rehearsal of previously taught content, helping teachers identify common misconceptions.

Where can I find Knowledge Organisers?

- Uploaded onto Show My Homework (SMHW) for homework assignments.
- Available for parents to view on our school website starting September.

How can I support my child's learning with Knowledge Organisers?

- Read through the Knowledge Organiser together.
- Try converting information into mind maps.
- Display in a frequently visited place for easy reference.
- Test regularly on spellings and key concepts.
- Encourage use of supportive strategies outlined in the attached help sheet.

How will teachers assess the impact of Knowledge Organisers?

- Through frequent assessment against Key Performance Indicators (KPIs).
- Student feedback will be valued and gathered through questionnaires on SMHW.
