KS3 (Years 7, 8):

- We offer Spanish, French at KS3
- We study the 4 skills of speaking, listening, reading and writing in topics such as 'me and my family',' free time', 'school life', 'tourism',' life style', 'work life' and 'world issues'.
- We do projects on culture and traditions
- We have a strong focus on literacy, by studying a foreign language it helps improving English skills in writing and communication.

KS 4 (Years 9, 10 and 11):

- MFL is an option at KS4.
- Smaller classes at KS4.

KS5 (Years 12 and 13 - 6th Form):

A GCSE, AS or A2 in a modern foreign language is highly recommended when applying for a University course
