TASSOMAI – YEAR 9 - 11 SCIENCE HOMEWORK 2018-19

We are pleased to announce that this academic year we will be using Tassomai, alongside written exam-style practice questions, as home learning for all Year 9, 10 and Year 11 students. Tassomai is an electronic multiple choice quiz system that works with your child's ability and adapts and develops along with their achievements. It will familiarise students with exam content and will quiz on all topics that could potentially be included in the GCSE AQA Science exams. By using Tassomai your child will increase their chances of obtaining great results!

Year 9 students are expected to complete a minimum of 60 correct questions a week. Year 10 students are expected to complete a minimum of 100 correct questions a week. Both year groups progress are checked on a Tuesday and non-completion detentions will be held on a Wednesday after school at 1:35pm.

Year 11 students are currently expected to complete a minimum of 100 correct questions a week. Progress will be checked on a Monday and non-completion detentions will be held on a week A Tuesday after school 3:00pm.

Tassomai Club runs during morning registration so there is the option for students to access Tassomai in school if they do not have other tutor time activities to complete. Priority will be given to Year 11.

If your child has any problems or questions regarding Tassomai, they should speak to their teacher as soon as possible.
