We are pleased to advise you of the plans for the forthcoming ASPIRE day on Tuesday 10 July 2018. The day will be themed around developing student Ambition where students will take part in different activities depending on their year group. Please see table below:

Alongside these year group activities we are delighted to be able to offer selected students a 'Medical Mavericks' workshop where students in Year 9 and Year 10 interested in medical job roles can participate in a session using ultrasound equipment, ECG and pulse monitoring etc.

We are also hosting for Years 7-10 a "Challenge the champions" sports science session where selected students can compare their fitness levels to famous athletes over a series of sports science challenges.

We have tried to offer a variety of activities to appeal to all students and to prepare them to be ambitious learners with the skills and experiences they will need in their future careers.

Students in year 9 will have a decision to make about what they wish to take part in on ASPIRE day. If your child has not yet had the opportunity to visit Bournemouth University and wishes to do so, then this would be an ideal opportunity.
