Re: 2022 Annual House Sports Day - Monday 4th July 2022

We are delighted to inform you that as part of the Academy's ASPIRE programme, the PE and ODE department will be running the annual House Sports Day this year.

The Bourne Academy House Sports Day is where students have signed up to compete in a number of different athletic events and participation activities, which run from Period 1 to Period 4. We run heats throughout the morning where students qualify for finals in the afternoon. The whole school can then watch the finals in the afternoon in House Areas on the field and the day will finish between 3:30pm – 4:00pm.

Parent/carers are invited to watch the track, relays, and the Tug of War finals from <u>2:15pm</u> on the school field. <u>Only parents/carers who have reserved tickets will be allowed entry to the Academy</u>. Tickets can be booked via <u>www.ticketsource.co.uk/the-bourne-academy</u> and limited to 4 per household.

All students are expected to participate in a sports day event or activity on the day. There are events for everyone including some extra activities that we hope will mean everyone has something they can engage in and win points for their House. It has been agreed that <u>ALL STUDENTS ARE TO WEAR TBA PE KIT FOR THIS DAY. This MUST be either TBA branded kit, black sports garments with no logos or fashion labels</u> (see planner uniform page for details) Anyone who feels they will be unable to comply with this uniform request or needs any support should speak to their PE teacher <u>PRIOR</u> to the day. Sanctions will apply for students not in correct uniform.

Students will also need plenty to drink and any other items appropriate to the weather: Sun cream, hats, and PE hoodies/Mid layers etc.

The day will be a celebration of sporting achievements, full of healthy competition between individuals and Houses. Students will have the chance to beat Academy records and one House will raise the trophy for the most sporting House.
