Catch up and Additional Learning sessions

Post- mock results, attendance at catch up sessions or additional learning will now be mandatory to ensure they receive targeted intervention to help them make progress towards their GCSE target grades. If your child has been advised to attend any of these sessions, we kindly ask for your help encouraging them to attend. Attending these sessions will help give your child the best opportunity to prepare for upcoming Year 11 exams.

If students do not attend a 60-minute Directors' Detention will be set so that the catch-up work can be completed. In line with the TBA policy, students who do not attend the detention will have to work in the Isolation Room for five lessons. However, we really hope that sanctions are not necessary, and students appreciate the extra provision designed to support them.
