Re: Residential Trip: PGL 4 March 2022 - 6 March 2022

We are pleased to announce our Year 11 Revision Residential weekend will be at Marchant's Hill PGL in Hindhead.

This will take place from Friday 4 March, leaving at approximately 14:00pm, until Sunday 6 March 2022, returning at approximately 19:00pm. The trip is designed to provide additional revision opportunities with specialist subject teachers from the Academy, focusing on securing a grade 5 or above in English and Maths.

There are a limited number of places available. Students will be prioritised based on their engagement with GEMS (Getting English Maths and Science) group and those who require additional support to secure a grade 5 or higher in English and Maths. Alongside the additional revision opportunities, students will also be able to participate in adventurous activities, such as Jacob's Ladder, to develop their resilience and team building skills.

The trip is being heavily subsidised by the Academy, to enable students to attend. The cost of the trip, after the contribution by the Academy, is £50 per student. The cost includes all meals, activities and transport. If your child is classified as pupil premium we ask for a contribution of £25 per student. Payments should be made as follows:

**Deposit of £20 by 14<sup>th</sup> January 2022** (£10 for pupil premium students) **Final payment of £30 by 14<sup>th</sup> February 2022** (£15 for pupil premium students)

I would be grateful if you could complete and return the attached paperwork including the consent form, Behaviour Contract and Medical questionnaire to the Academy no later than 14<sup>th</sup> January 2022 along with the £20 deposit to secure their place on this exciting trip.

Please find attached the kit list with all the items your child will need for the trip.

It would be preferable if payments for the trip could be paid using the Academy's online payment system (<a href="www.scopay.com">www.scopay.com</a>), accessible via the Parents Section of the Academy website. Payments using this method can be made at anytime, including over the Christmas holidays. If you do wish to pay using cash or cheque (payable to 'The Bourne Academy') then please ensure that this is placed in a sealed envelope with your child's name and details of payment clearly marked on the front and hand in to the Academy reception.

Payments can be made in installments; please contact the Finance Department to discuss these arrangements, as we do not wish students to refrain from attending this trip.

If the trip is oversubscribed then students will be allocated according to their GEMS group participation.
