Year 7 End of Year Assessment

27 June – 1 July 2022

English

Students will sit one 45-minute writing examination in class during Summer 1 and one 45-minute formal reading examination in Summer 2. Each paper will form 50% of their final grade. The in-class assessment will be a writing assessment for which students will be prepared during lesson time. The formal reading examination will assess the knowledge and skills students have obtained throughout their time in Year 7 so far. There will be a combination of multiple-choice questions as well as answers which require the students to write a detailed response in full sentences.

- **Writing**
 - Descriptive writing content and organisation
 - Spelling, punctuation and grammar
- **Reading**
 - Comprehension of an unseen fiction text
 - Identifying language techniques
 - Identifying structural techniques
 - Analysing language and structure
