Dear Parent/Carer,

Many of you will have heard the announcements from the Prime Minister yesterday evening explaining that people should avoid "non-essential" travel and contact with others as well as begin to work from home where possible. As a school at the heart of its community we are fully prepared to support the Government request to remain open but more importantly to provide this service to our families. However, to enable us to forward plan in the event of a full school closure, we request that parents who work in the health service to please make contact with the main office on admin@thebourneacademy.com to inform us of your role.

I am writing to let you know that The Bourne Academy will **NOT** be able to be open to all students tomorrow (Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> March 2020). Whilst we do not have any confirmed cases of Covid-19, unfortunately, we have insufficient staff to safely supervise students, therefore, we have taken the reluctant decision to ask **Year 9 students to remain at home until further notice**. We have discussed, in detail, the order of priority for releasing year groups. The rationale for asking Year 9 students to be the first year group to remain at home is that the imminent examination year groups could be at greater academic disadvantage. Parents are more likely to be able to make arrangements with Year 9 students than with Year 7 or 8. However, this remains an ever-changing situation and we will have to make decisions on a day by day basis.

Staff are fully aware of the potential disruption that a partial school closure will have on parents and the imminent exam period and we will continue to monitor this situation. However, you will appreciate that these are unprecedented times and our priority must be the health and safety of our students, our staff and, of course, our wider community.

Please note actions for your information which will come into force from tomorrow:

- Year 9 will be asked to remain at home until further notice. Work will be available for Year 9 on Show My Homework from tomorrow (Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> March 2020), further work will then be posted every Monday
- Year 9 teachers will be used to cover any staff who are absent owing to the latest Government guidelines
- All UK and international trips are cancelled or postponed until we receive further guidance
- All ACE clubs and internal events will be cancelled or postponed until further notice

Please can I ask that Year 9 students do not come to School at the end of the day to meet and socialise with other year groups. I will ensure that I keep you informed of any changes to the above arrangements, however, please continue to monitor our website for further updates.
