# **Update on Previous Actions**

#### **Principal's Briefing**

#### 1. Coronavirus Pandemic

MA talked about all the changes which have been made since the start of the pandemic. Behaviour is fantastic and online learning fabulous – students adapting brilliantly and thanks to all students and families for all support given.

- Wet breaks we're planning more shelters eg. marquees (one already trialled). From Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> November, we launching a new indoor lunch area for each year group, for approx. 30 students at a time. The staffing arrangement for this is massive covering indoors and outdoors at the same time, so thank you for your patience up until now. MA letter home.
- **Food Lessons** We're very proud of our practical subjects here at TBA, so delighted to say that Yr 7 has already started a rotation of practical food lessons, and Yr 8 are due to start soon.
- Extra curricular clubs The government advice has been very woolly around this, with no clear
  advice either way. Our decision is to cancel all extra curricular clubs until the national lockdown is
  over, then look to introduce clubs again if appropriate after the 2<sup>nd</sup> December announcement. MA
  to communicate home.
- Attendance we are proud of our pandemic attendance: nationally is 83% and at TBA is 93%.
- **Peri lessons/music** these have continued as normal

### Parent Feedback on pandemic -

Mental impact on shielding families needing to send their children to school – conflicting advice from medics v educationalists is often hard to marry up. Grateful for all TBA's support in this.

Other parent comments that TBA has been brilliant and work has been great online.

Please could Outdoor Ed minibus please drop off students to the front carpark so as not to breach the bubble of exiting 6<sup>th</sup> formers at the back gate (if the time clashes with an exit). CG to action.

#### The Bourne Foundation & Annual Fund Letters

We are delighted to announce that the Bourne Foundation made over £28,000 last year to help with all the extra costs we need to fund to help our students. Over £2000 of that was made through the Parental Annual Fund. Every year we discuss at PVT if it is still suitable to ask for parental contributions: it was agreed that we should proceed this year as normal, provided the letter is sensitively worded due to the pandemic/financial pressures on families. - Can we ask parents to **keep their food and locker £ balances** at the end of a year/end of time at TBA (yr 11/13), and put this money towards the TBF? Great idea. CG to write a template letter to go out asking to keep any final remaining funds.
- Can we ask parents to keep any remaining childcare voucher funds in the pot? MA/CG to enquire with finance department to see if this is possible, and to action if so.

#### **Ten Year Anniversary**

CG explained that we are making the best of celebrating our 10<sup>th</sup> anniversary, despite no events being permitted. We are doing this through logos and references wherever possible, banners, advertising, press articles, planned aerial photo, Canford staff quiz night. Canford School is building a new stone walkway – for every funded stone they receive, they have so kindly pledged to donate a book to our reading programme. We have two titles x 30 books already in progress.
