How will you be assessed?

No formal examination for the Diploma. However one of the units will be set and marked by the exam board.

All other units are entirely assignment based and set/marked internally by staff. Units can vary therefore can carry a different share towards the final grade. Level 3 BTECs are awarded either, Pass, Merit or Distinction.

The new BTEC Nationals use a combination of assessment styles to give students the confidence they need to apply their knowledge and to succeed in the work-place – this will ultimately prepare them with the study skills needed to continue learning throughout their career.

The Level 3 BTECs in Creative Digital Media Production have been developed to focus on providing opportunities for full-time learners to gain nationally recognised vocational specific qualification to enter employment in the media industries or progress to higher education vocational qualifications such as BTEC Higher National Diploma in Media degree. The Level 3 BTEC Diploma offers the same number of UCAS points as two A levels respectively.
