

16 - 19 TUTITON FUND

The Government 16 - 19 tuition fund £96 million of one-off funding for the academic year 2020/21 only. It is provided to 16 to 19 providers to mitigate the disruption to learning arising from coronavirus (COVID -19).

The funding is being provided to support small group tuition for 16-19 student in English, Maths and other courses where learning has been disrupted. Although funding is not specifically for GCSE English or Maths, the students supported all need to be those who had not achieved grade 5 or above in at least one of those subjects by he age of 16. All supported students must be on a 16-19 study course. Providers should prioritise students that will benefit most from small group tuition, based on the criteria above.

The Bourne Academy has been allocated £7,128 for 16 to 19 tuition.
