Pastoral Update

- First Impressions Card Successful Rollout Since the start of term, we have seen the lowest numbers ever of students in Isolation – the FIC cards are working well and students are actively avoiding strikes. We continue to monitor how many SEN students end up in ISO, and will manage those individual cases carefully.
- 2. Rewards processes and structure (including staff consistency) under consultation and parents will be informed asap. Rewards trip are coming back to normal.
- **3.** Blazers CJI is aware that a batch of new blazers is prone to buttons falling off these blazers can be taken back to the shop and the glitch is being fixed.

Principal's Briefing

- Summer School Transition process was limited for this year's yr 7. So great that an external company ran a summer school with Gov funding (54K) (although it was actually run by HB internally, with our own staff!). Excellent week with a day trip and electronic devices given at the end. In a feedback survey, all 118 responses were excellent.
- 2. Proms/Arts Awards very successful and worth putting them on (despite the numerous Covid date changes!). Thanks for your support with these.
- **3.** Staggered Start/Covid Testing thanks for your patience staggered start much needed for yrs 7/8/12 and for running almost 2000 LFD covid tests
- 4. Road Safety please remind students to cross at designated crossings. Action: CG to email to parents with reminder of yr group badge colours
- 5. BTEC School of the Year 2021 this was very important and big news, so delighted

- 6. MiSST Music in Secondary Schools Trust have chosen TBA as their only school in the South and to be part of only 22 schools nationally providing free classical music lessons, concerts and instruments to Years 7&8 from Sept 22. Patrons include Lord Andrew Lloyd Weber and Nicola Benedetti. A private donor has kindly given £45K towards instruments and musical equipment. This is life changing for our Academy and our students. We're extremely excited about it.
- 7. Greenpower Car National Competition We have just won best presented team at the latest September races in Goodwood, and are going on to once again race in the International finals.
