

16 – 19 TUITION FUND 2021 TO 2022 ACADEMIC YEAR

The Government 16 - 19 tuition fund is funding issued to providers 16 to 19 education to mitigate the disruption to learning arising from coronavirus (COVID -19).

The funding is being provided to support small group tuition for 16-19 student in English, Maths and other courses where learning has been disrupted, including vocational and/or academic learning. This funding is to assist students who have not achieved a grade 4 or 5 in English and/or Maths or have achieved a grade 4 in these subjects, but are from an economically disadvantaged background and would benefit from catch-up support. Students aged 19 to 24 who have an EHCP are also eligible for support.

For 2021/22 we are prioritising our tuition fund allocation on:

- support for the students who have not achieved a grade 4 in English and/or Maths
- supporting the learning of disadvantaged students who have not achieved grade 5 or above in at least one of English and Maths
- supporting the learning of disadvantaged students in their chosen subjects where their learning was disrupted due to lockdown.

Our support will involve:

- additional teaching hours of Maths and/or English in small groups for those students in Year 12 and Year 13 that have not achieved a grade 4 in one or both of these subjects. Groups will number no more than 5.
- provision of revision guides and support materials to assist the students with this work
- additional sessions for vocational subjects for disadvantaged students to improve and develop their practical skills required for these courses.
