Update on Previous Actions (Nov 2020)

Pastoral Update

- 1. First Impressions Card Successful Yr 9 Pilot students adapted well and gave positive feedback. Very few students reaching five strikes, Line ups/equipment checks all much smoother. Yr 9 has risen to the challenge and we have been proud to recognise and reward positive behaviour. Long term, the FI Card will be paper and stapled into the students' planner. We have only had two queries from parents, and communication channels remain open to parents at all times. As a reward and thank you to Yr 9, we have planned a Thorpe Park Trip in September. Now working on whole school roll-out from September currently in consultation with staff/students and parents, answering questions etc.
- GS mentioned there had been an issue for her son (SEN), but that it was resolved brilliantly and quickly with lots of support.
- BW asked if the scheme was too negatively focussed, KF responded that actually it is a really positive initiative and has been received as such.

2. Rewards

- WP asked what reward there was for her daughter with so many positive points and others like her?
 KF to investigate this and report back.
- MA added that rewarding students has been difficult and sorely missed during the Covid pandemic (no trips, food etc), but should resume fully from September.
- KS commented that there was an inconsistency between the amount of points being awarded, from
 one teacher to another, and she requested we did an internal audit of how teachers are awarding
 points consistently. KF replied that this is under review and will report back.
- MA talked about 1000 Club (1000 points) 50 students in year 10 have it and even more in Yr 7. There is going to be a new App for ASPIRE points, which will be very positive.

Principal's Briefing

- **1. Thank you** Thanks for ongoing support parents, students, staff have all been fantastic during the last year tutor groups and lessons all exemplary. We are delighted with our pandemic attendance figures of 91%, better than the national figure of 84%.
- **2. Transition** Now concentrating on ensuring our 183 new Year 7s get as good a Transition as possible they have been joining in our new Steps to Aspire activity programme from home and will be attending summer school in August.
- 3. Summer School we have been working hand in hand with the company who is running the Summer School it will be well run and staffed. Despite the year they've had, we had 30 staff volunteer to work that week we'll be appointing ten of them. MA will be delivering the Assembly on the Thursday. The programme looks brilliant and we already have 143 Yr 7s signed up (they have until end June with the company chasing sign ups). Any spare capacity will go to next year's Yr 8s, first come first served we imagine approx. 40 places to be opened up.
- **4. September Start Dates** planning to be fully onsite we will be running an extended Transition start for the new Yr 7s and Yr 8s (who missed out on so much last September too). See website/term dates for start days likely:

- 7 Sept yr 7s + testing
- 8 Sept yr 7/8 + testing
- 9 Sept Yr 7/8/12 + testing
- 10 Sept Whole school + testing
- **5. PA & Visual Arts** been amazing throughout pandemic. There will be some national news surrounding this and all BTEC subjects from 7 July watch social media. Massive thanks for all your support in these areas.

Other news

- **1. Gold DofE** leaving for Scotland tomorrow ends at Buckingham Palace, so a great opportunity. Hats off to PE dept. DofE numbers have increased over pandemic, when getting out there was hardest brilliant!
- **2. Canford Partnership** due to expand our joint activities with more opportunities for linking both schools
- **3. Police Cadets** New Police Commissioner visiting the school on 8 July. GS asked if currently running? MA to email if places are available. Head Cadet just been chosen and is a TBA student.
- **4. 170 Pink Lockers arrived** funding by BCP £13,000.
- **5. Osiligi Virtual Journey** finished in May and was a huge success in uniting the community. Prizes awarded.
- 6. Sports Day 5 July and ASPIRE Day 6 July, with a drone photo being taken of all students.
