Step 1: As a student, you will need to sign up to the Speakers for Schools portal by clicking the link - [Young person registration](#).

Step 2: Once registered, review the opportunities available by clicking on the links below. These opportunities are only available to select Dorset schools and therefore will not be accessible through the portal's primary search function.

Step 3: Choose the opportunity that interests you the most. Think about the careers you would like to learn about and the skills you may develop from attending the specific placement. Once decided, use the portal link above to apply for the application. During the application process, you will need to submit answers to questions asked by the employer.

Step 4: Once complete, the application will go to your teacher to review.

Step 5: Your teacher will review your application and then confirm they are happy for you to proceed. Once accepted, it will go to the employer for review.

All applications need to be completed and submitted by May 21st.

The employers will review all the applications and will confirm if you have been successful by **June 8th**.

All successful applicants will then receive their log-in details and a 'How-to-access Google Classroom' guide.

On the day of the placement, all students will need to log into Google Classroom at 09:45 to be ready to start at 10:00. All opportunities will finish by 15:00.
