Teachus Summer School Programme

We are delighted to see that so many of our new intake have signed up for the Teachus Summer School from $16^{th}-20^{th}$ August. If you have signed your child up for the Summer School, you will receive an email containing a link to consent and medical forms. We ask that all forms are completed and submitted before the first day of the Summer School. Students will not be allowed on school site without these being completed. In addition, please bring your child to the registration station on the first day of the Summer School, before leaving your child at the Academy. We would request that Parents/Carers wear masks whilst waiting with their child to register on the first day, please.

Trinity House

We wish to inform you that Mrs Betteridge, currently Head of House for Trinity, will be relinquishing this role with effect from September. This will allow Mrs Betteridge to focus on her role as a SENDCo, at a time when school inclusion is at its greatest demand following Covid-19. Please be reassured that Mrs Betteridge will remain at the Academy next academic year. Trinity House will be overseen by Mrs Twigg in the interim.

Lateral Flow Testing

New Government Guidance has recently been published to school with details around Lateral Flow Tests (LFT) at the start of the academic year. For our new Year 7 intake (your child), this will take place on **Monday 6 September.** Your child will be invited in, at a specific time on this date, to take a LFT. Your child will leave school site once the LFT has been carried out. Further information on this process will be sent to you nearer the time. A second LFT will need to be carried out on each student, within the same week. The second test will occur whilst your child is in school for the day. Your child is due to have their second LFT on **Friday 10 September.** This information was provided in a letter emailed on 15 July 2021 and contained links to the consent form to allow us to test your child.
