RE: Parent Teacher Consultation Evenings

I am writing to provide you with details of our Parent Teacher Consultation Evenings this academic year. We are aware just how important it is to ensure high quality communication between school and home. We are confident that the time invested in these evenings ensures the best possible outcomes for your child during their time with us at the Academy.

Students in all year groups will have two parents' evenings a year, at times most relevant to their academic challenges and in line with their assessment programmes. All evenings will run from 3:00pm-6:00pm.

Over recent years we have developed the use of a blended approach to Parent Teacher Consultation Evenings including both in person and online meeting formats using the School Cloud system. Following each PTC we received feedback from parents, carers and teachers on the evening and the overwhelming feedback has been a preference for face-to-face appointments taking place in school.

As you will recognise from the schedule below most PTCs will take place in person in school, with a small number taking place online. We aim for this blended approach to support the building of our school community with face-to-face appointments, while also keeping the flexible element of online appointments.

We will utilise the School Cloud booking system for you to book appointments for both in person and virtual parents' evenings. We will write to you approximately three weeks before each PTC with details of how to book your appointments.
