However, a number of students have arrived at school with trainers on. I am acutely aware that manufacturers like JD Sports, Sports Direct, Nike, Adidas or Reebok all label some of their trainers as "school shoes". However, the description and logos of these are clearly trainers. I have listed a couple of examples of these below. The images below come from Sports Direct and are not an exhaustive list but these types of footwear are clearly trainers. **They are NOT** acceptable.

These Nike Court Borough Trainers are designed with elasticated laces and hook and loop tape fastening. They feature a padded ankle collar and tongue for comfort and support. These trainers have a loop tab to the heel and a chunky midsole. They also have a grip sole and are complete with Nike Swoosh branding.
