The Cambridge Technicals in Business is a Level 3 qualification for students aged 16+. It is a vocational qualification which develops students' core skills and understanding of the requirements of the business sector. Students gain hands-on experience and have the opportunity to focus on specific topics such as human resources, marketing, accounting, international business and more.

Students will learn a range of important and transferable skills. The tasks they complete will help them to develop planning, time management and research skills as well as problem solving and decision making. Students will also required to manipulate data in a variety of forms and interpret their results.

You will be assessed through both coursework and external unit examinations over the 2-year period.

How will you learn?

Students will be using a range of techniques and skills in order to learn and revise key business topics. This includes practical activities, challenges, group work, independent studying and research and analysis. Each unit is very specific, yet compliments other units, making the topic easy to understand and apply to a broad context.

Where will it take you?

The Level 3 Cambridge Technicals in Business qualification will help students to achieve their full potential and progress to the next stage of their lives, whether that's higher education, an apprenticeship or employment. Many students go on to take a degree in Business or in connected areas such as Accountancy, Management, International Business, Economics or Law, whilst other students will secure employment and apprenticeships covering a wide range of specialisms.

What do I need to study this course?

Five or more 9-4 grades at GCSE including English and Maths. At least a grade 4/Pass in Level 2 Business Studies. If Business was not studied at Level 2 at least a grade 5 in GCSE English and Maths.
