Important Information About Attendance and Behaviour:

This event is a **free reward** for students who have achieved over **95% attendance** for the Spring term and maintained a positive behaviour record. In the rare instance that a student's behaviour has fallen below the expectations of The Bourne Academy, they will not be invited to the event. If this applies to your child, their Head of Year will be in contact to advise you of this decision. Consent to attend the disco should be provided using the Arbor Parent Portal – this will be open until midday on Thursday 3 April.

For students with **attendance below 95%**, there will be a £2.50 charge to attend the event. Payment for the disco can be made via the Academy's online payment system - <u>www.scopay.com</u>. If your child has attendance below this level, then please ensure that the £2.50 payment is made on scopay as well as providing consent to attend on the Arbor parent portal.

Students should enter and be collected via the **rear vehicle gate**, accessible via **The Lawn area**. Please ensure your child arrives on time for their session and is collected promptly at the end of their designated time. For safety reasons, students will only be allowed to leave with a parent or carer unless otherwise arranged in advance.

Drinks and snacks will be available to purchase at the event. Students can look forward to a lovely evening filled with music, games, and dancing!
