This may involve removing their social time and supervising them in a classroom setting. Our aim in implementing these measures is to reinforce the values of respect, responsibility, and consideration. We are committed to fostering a positive and inclusive community where every individual feels valued and supported. It is through collaboration and mutual respect that we can create an environment conducive to learning and personal growth for all our students.

Please take this opportunity to discuss with your child the importance of respectful behaviour and the impact their actions can have on those around them. Together, we can reinforce these values both within the Academy setting and beyond.
